

Supplemental information, analysis of PFOA and ulcerative colitis

Ulcerative Colitis (UC)

Below are the quartile cutpoints, and mean/medians for the quartiles (no lag), for the categorical analyses of ulcerative colitis, which were used in the probable link cancer analyses of the C8 Science Panel cohort study of auto-immune disease, and which were later published in Steenland et al. 2013*. 2013 (Table 3). The means and medians are weighted by the amount of person-time spent by cohort members in the respective quartiles.
